Entry Requirements

General entry requirement for studies at the first cycle with the exception of Swedish 1, 2, 3 or the equivalent.

Specific entry requirement

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Selection

If there are more qualified applicants than places on the programme, a selection is made based on SKH's selection criteria for first cycle education. Selection takes place by assessing a submitted filmed sample and by a series of practical selection tests. The selection is made by an admissions group.

Language of Instruction

English.

Aim

The aim of the Bachelor's Programme in Mime Acting is to provide the student with the knowledge, competences and skills required for physically oriented performance, emphasizing corporeal expression and specific methodologies for creating and performing physical theatre.

Programme Structure

Mime is the main subject of the programme, followed by performance practice and performance creation. Acrobatics and movement, dance, voice, theatre theory and critical reflection, etc. are complementary subjects. Through the foundation mime provides, through the encounter with other forms of movement and by working with varying narratives, the student trains the ability to create performances with movement as the main tool. Text can have a supporting function but is rarely the main starting point. The student is trained to make independent choices in a collective work process. The student's own creativity is central in both the creation of their own works and in degree production.

Rules for further studies within the program are stated in the form of eligibility requirements within each course syllabus.

Intended Learning Outcomes

Knowledge and understanding

After completing the programme the student shall:

• demonstrate knowledge and understanding in the principal field (main field of study), including knowledge of the practical and theoretical foundation of the field, knowledge and experience of methods and processes in the field as well as specialised study within the field.

Competence and skills

After completing the programme the student shall:

- demonstrate the ability to describe, analyse and interpret design, techniques and content as
 well as to reflect critically on his or her artistic approach and that of others in the main field
 of study,
- demonstrate the ability in the main field of study to create, realise and express his or her own
 ideas, identify, formulate and solve artistic and creative problems and to undertake artistic
 tasks within predetermined time frames,
- demonstrate the ability to present and discuss his or her works and artistic issues in speech, writing or in other ways and in dialogue with different audiences, and
- demonstrate the competence and knowledge required to work autonomously in a professional capacity.

Judgement and approach

After completing the programme the student shall:

- demonstrate the ability to make assessments in the main field of study informed by relevant artistic, social and ethical issues,
- demonstrate insight into the role of art in society, and
- demonstrate the ability to identify the need for further knowledge and ongoing learning.

Independent Degree Project

A requirement for the award of a Bachelor of Fine Arts is completion by the student, within the frame of the course requirements, of an independent project (degree project) for at least 15 credits in the main field of study.
