Entry Requirements

General Entry Requirements:

for studies at the first cycle with the exception of Swedish 1-3 and English 6.

Specific Entry Requirements:

45 credits from year 1 within the Bachelor Programme in Dance Performance

Selection

Students in the programme are guaranteed a place.

Language of Instruction

The main language of instruction is English.

Course Content

In this course, the student completes an individual art project in which they frame and deepen their knowledge within one of three perspectives: dance, performance or choreography. The student devises a process specific to their interests to develop their understanding of and practice within their chosen specialization.

Teaching Forms

Workshops, lectures and supervision.

Intended Learning Outcomes

After completing the course the student is able to:

- 1) demonstrate the skills developed in their chosen specialization within the framework of an art project
- 2) identify and utilize a form of writing that meaningfully documents the process and
- 3) verbally articulate the knowledge and skills developed in the chosen area of specialization through their individual project.

Examination

(1001) Practical assignment, 4 credits, regarding learning outcome 1, Grades Fail (U) or Pass (G).

(1001) Praktisk uppgift, 4 hp, avseende lärandemål 1, betyg Underkänt (U) eller Godkänt (G).

(1002) Written and oral assignment, 3.5 credits, regarding learning outcome 2-3, Grades Fail (U) or Pass (G).

(1002) Skriftlig och muntlig uppgift, 3,5 hp, avseende lärandemål 2-3, betyg Underkänt (U) eller Godkänt (G).

If a student has a decision from Stockholm University of the Arts about special pedagogical support due to functional variance, the examiner can decide on alternative forms of examination in consultation with the student.

Course Requirements

Study material
