Selection

If there are more qualified applicants than places a selection will be made. The selection will be based on an assessment of merits uploaded with the application. An entrance examination may be conducted.

Language of Instruction

The main language of instruction is English.

Course Content

Musically, students will study an opera role of their choice, with in-depth study of the musical dramatic interpretation of parts of the role. The pedagogical methods used in the course are singing lessons, musical study, role analysis, lessons in stage performance and reflective seminars.

Teaching Forms

Teaching takes place individually and in group lessons. The student is expected to pursue extensive self studies within all course moments.

Intended Learning Outcomes

After completing the course, the student is able to:

- 1. demonstrate the ability to perform musical drama
- 2. explain in-depth methods for studying and interpreting a musical drama role.

Examination

Seminar and a semi-staged performance, 15 credits, regarding learning outcomes 1-2, grades Fail (U) or Pass (G)

If a student has a decision from Stockholm University of the Arts about special pedagogical support due to functional variance, the examiner can decide on alternative forms of examination in consultation with the student.
