Course Content

The course contains practice, physical learning, discussions and own work, as well as written assignments related to the student's own process and formulated question.

With Klein TechniqueTM as a starting point and tool, the student deepens and develops their own artistic question, through constant shifts between theory and practice.

Teaching Forms

Teacher-controlled tuition and independent work.

After completing the course the student is able to:

- physically and theoretically be able to show a deepened knowledge and understanding to the principals and executions of Klein Technique
- verbally and in text reflect in-depth on their own practice, and formulate a theoretical model for working with their own practice in relation to Klein Technique, and to their own question
- critically assess and relate the possibilities of Klein Technique in relation to their own artistic and/or pedagogical practice, and in relation to their own question
