Entry Requirements

General Entry Requirements:

for studies at the first cycle with the exception of Swedish 1-3 and English 6.

Specific Entry Requirements:

60 credits in choreography or dance, or equivalent.

Selection

Selection is made by assessing the feasibility of the applicant's project idea, in relation to the course content.

Language of Instruction

The main language of instruction is English.

Course Content

The students is given the opportunity to further develop their artistic idea through supervision and work with feedback as a method for artistic specialization. The course contains workshops in methods for feedback, independent work in the studio, individual supervision/conversations with supervisors, as well as writing that further develops the student's ability to formulate and articulate their artistic process.

Teaching Forms

Workshops, feedback, individual supervision and independent work.

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Intended Learning Outcomes

After completing the course the student is able to:

- 1. work with and further develop their artistic idea,
- 2. reflect and articulate on their own artistic process during the unfolding of the course and
- 3. show knowledge and understanding of the feedback methods used during the course.
